





Well-reasoned Study

It is best described as being sequential and thinking in steps

Logic is the art of thinking

Reasoning is understanding the human limitations and incapacities

If young children understand the importance of being able to think critically, we can empower them and arm them with the greatest tool they will ever carry with them into adulthood.


Understanding the biases one may have as a human being by determining what exactly they are and how they may affect the way one deals with information, leads to better decisionmaking with fewer mistakes Logical Reasoning helps develop the following types of memory:

Motor Memory - the ability to memorise routinely performed movement and recall muscle coordination

Verbal-Logical Memory - the ability to store and use verbal information that is heard

Visual-Shape Memory - the ability to recognise and distinguish forms, faces, colours and visual elements

Emotional Memory - the ability to capture feelings and connect them to related events








Logical thinking skills are essential to the health of any workplace environment. They help you become a better team player because you are unlikely to let your emotions and ego cloud your judgement and then make a decision or come up with a solution. The ability on an individual level tends to translate to organisational success eventually


Investment in knowledge pays the best interest
